Chocolate Celadon Dreams

A soft, gray-blue color palette with hints of ocean-inspired greens create a cool, restful atmosphere in the master retreat, where accents of chocolate can be found in the faux glazed walls and large bronzed medallions, and add a whisper of warmth to the space. Designer Cindy Davis found inspiration in the sitting room's top valance fabric motif, reminiscent of ocean coral. This area also features a mural creating the illusion of rich folds of silk flowing from the ceiling into the room's actual silk panels of rich chocolate and soft shimmering blues. The master tray ceiling features wood lathing strips over the bed to create a harlequin grid with gold leaf accents. Overall, this room creates a balance of scale and color, which is continued in the master bath. A mix of travertine, glass mosaic, and rustic tiles were used throughout this spa bath to help create a luxuriant atmosphere.
